MASSES

- All public celebration of Mass will be suspended starting Wed. Mar. 18, 2020

 - * Fr. Peter Augustine will offer private Masses (without the congregation present) daily at 8:30AM and for each of our regular Lord's Day Masses. Our daily Masses and our Sunday ~~10:30AM~~ **8:30AM** Mass will be **Live Streamed** on our **Parish Facebook Page** (St. Mary's Catholic Church). You will also have available to you every Sunday our **Radio Mass** at 10:30am on **WKBI 1400AM and 94.5 FM**

- * Homebound communion visits will be suspended
- * Emergency Anointing of the Sick will be available. Call the parish office
